PRELIMINARY WORK

1 - Activating the 48V electrical system



 Activate the 48V electrical system by closing the bonnet.


The activation takes place automatically.

2 - Disconnecting all battery earth leads





3 - Remove the cover of the engine compartment at the rear left



- Loosen the lock (1).
- Remove the cover (2).

4 – Remove the cover of the rear right engine compartment



- Loosen the lock (1).
- Remove the cover (2).

► Covering the vehicle battery



Unprotected battery terminals.

• Cover the battery with the special tool **2 452 007** as shown.

5 - Remove left and right wiper arm



Description is for left component only. Procedure on the right side is identical.


► Remove the wiper arm




Damage to wiper console.

While removing the wiper arms without using special tool, the wiper console can break.

- Removing the wiper arms must be carried out only using the prescribed special tool.
- Do not lever off the wiper arm because otherwise the wiper console may break at the predetermined breaking point for active pedestrian protection.




- Remove the protective cap (1).
- Loosen nut (2).



 Pull off the wiper arm (1) using special tool 0 493 441 (61 6 060).

6 - Remove cowl panel cover




- Release the cowl panel cover (1) from the latch mechanisms (2) and (3).
- Pull off the cowl panel cover (1) towards the top, starting from the side.

7 - Removing trailing link at spring strut dome




Driving without the strut brace/front-end strut or tension strut is not permitted.



• Version 1:

Loosen screws (1) and (2).

Remove tension strut (3) in the spring strut dome upwards.

Loosen screws (1) and (2).

Remove tension strut (3) in the spring strut dome upwards.

8 – Removing 12 V dual storage system



Working on 12 V vehicle electrical system.


Risk of short circuits! Risk of fire!

- Make sure that no charger is connected to the jump start support point in the engine compartment.
- Detach battery earth lead from battery.
- With auxiliary batteries: Detach all battery earth leads from additional batteries.



- Loosen the latch mechanisms (1).
- Remove positive terminal cover (2).
- Loosen nut (3).
- Remove battery rollover protection bracket (4).
- Unlock plug connection (5) and disconnect.



- Loosen nut (1).
- Pull off positive battery cable (2) from the positive terminal and secure at side.




Unprotected battery terminals.

- Cover the vehicle battery.
- Fold back grab handle and remove the 12-V dual storage battery (3).

9 - Install 12-V dual storage battery






Incorrect screw connection of the battery cable.

- Make sure that the battery cable is screwed together with the correct nut.
- Install the 12 V dual storage system (3).
- Position the positive battery cable (2) on the positive terminal.
- Tighten nut (1).

• Check the guide (1) and the retaining lugs (2) on the positive terminal cover (3) for damage.

Result

"> Guides (1) or retaining lugs (2) are damaged.

Measure

- Renew positive terminal cover (3).
- Connect connectors (5) and lock.
- Install battery rollover protection bracket (4).
- Tighten nut (3).



10 - Install tension strut on spring strut dome.





11 – Installing cowl panel cover



Before installing the cowl panel cover it is **mandatory** to check that the 48 V line is routed correctly and fitted tightly.

An incorrectly laid or attached 48 V line can be damaged by the wiper kinematics.



- Starting on the side, push the cowl panel cover (1) into the latch mechanism at the top.
- Engage cowl panel cover (1) into the latch mechanisms (2) and (3).

12 – Install left and right wiper arm



Description is for left component only. Procedure on the right side is identical.


► Install left and right wiper arm



The wiper system must be in zero position.

After installing the cowl panel cover and before fitting the wiper arm:


Activate the wiper system once to ensure that it has the correct installation position.



- Connect the wiper arms (3).
- Correctly position the wiper arm (2) in relation to the window edge (1).

Distance from window pane edge to wiper blade

Wiper arm right (A) 65 mm
Wiper arm left (B) 58 mm





16 - Deactivating the 48V electrical system




• Deactivate the 48V electrical system by opening the bonnet.

The deactivation takes place automatically.

► Determining the absence of voltage in the 48V electrical system



Zero voltage (48V electrical system is switched off) is displayed only in PAD mode.



Check

- Press the START-STOP button quickly 3 times without stepping on the brake pedal to establish the PAD mode.
- Check that the instrument cluster (KOMBI) is deenergized in PAD mode.

desired state

 The Check Control message "48V vehicle electrical system switched off." Or "Electrical additional storage switched off." (1) is displayed.

Result

>> The absence of voltage cannot be determined by means of the Check Control message "48V vehicle electrical system switched off:" Or "Electrical additional storage switched off." (1). Work is not permitted to be started.

Measure

- Carry out the service function "48 V electrical system deactivation".
 - Vehicle management > Service functions > Voltage supply > Deactivate 48 V electrical system

Only when the Check Control message "48V electrical system switched off." Or "Electrical additional storage switched off." (1) is displayed in the instrument cluster (KOMBI), may the 12 V battery be disconnected.

Result

>> The absence of voltage cannot be determined by means of the Check Control message "48V vehicle electrical system switched off:" Or "Electrical additional storage switched off." (1). Work is not permitted to be started.

Measure

See additional information:

48V battery with fault code related to relay is stuck in closed position and de-energized

Result

The Check Control message signals that the 48V electrical system has been switched off.

Measure

 Exit the PAD mode by pressing the START-STOP button once without pressing the brake pedal.

The work "Disconnecting the negative battery cable of the 48-V battery" can be started.


